In 1956, he married his beautiful wife Beverly and joined the Air Force to serve his country for four years. In 1962, he joined the Long Beach Police Department. Ed worked in various Units and Divisions including ten years in the Motor Patrol Unit, and many more as the Range Master at the Academy. One of Corporal Davenport's passions was the SWAT Team, where he served for over 30 years of all capacities. Ed and Beverly have two sons and a daughter. Both sons have followed in their father's footsteps, one a Long Beach Police Sergeant, the other a Murrieta Police Lieutenant. - ◆ Submit a maximum of 300 words essay explaining what you hope to achieve with your degree
- ◆ Obtain a signature from the guardian who is a Long Beach Officer (unless deceased)
