### Size of Award

**\$500** - Four awards per calendar year.

### Eligibility Requirements

- Admitted to, and enrolled in, a four year undergraduate degree program.
- Current Long Beach Police Officer and LBPOA Member in good standing.
- Applicants must be full-time or part-time\*, undergraduate students, who have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00 and have at least a sophomore class standing.
- Seeking degree that will directly enhance career objectives with the Long Beach Police Department.

### Duration of Eligibility

Maximum of two awards per person per lifetime (\$1000 maximum), one award per person per year (one award \$500 per year).

Selection Criteria:

1. Must meet all eligibility requirements as listed on opposite side.
2. \* Definition of full-time or part-time student: An undergraduate student carrying 12 or more units during the fall or spring semester is classified as a full-time student. A graduate or post-baccalaureate student carrying 9 or more units during the fall or spring semester is also classified as a full-time student. An undergraduate student carrying fewer than 12 units or a graduate or post-baccalaureate student carrying fewer than 9 units is classified as a part-time student. These definitions derive from federal financial aid regulations and have no bearing on the definitions used by the State of California to determine a student's liability for the State University Fee.
